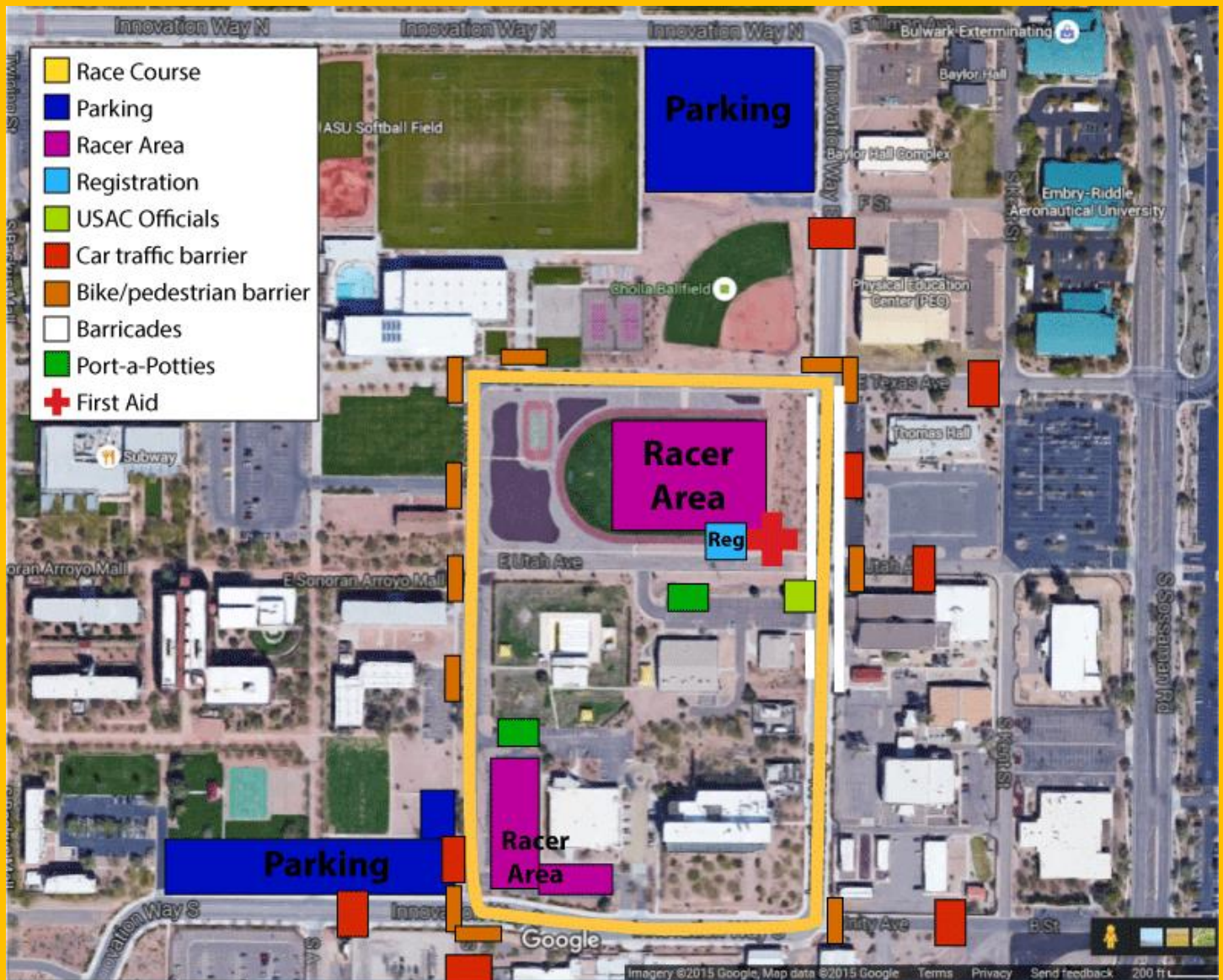

Fast, flat, 4 corners; 0.7 miles; raced clockwise; good pavement; finish on Innovation Way East



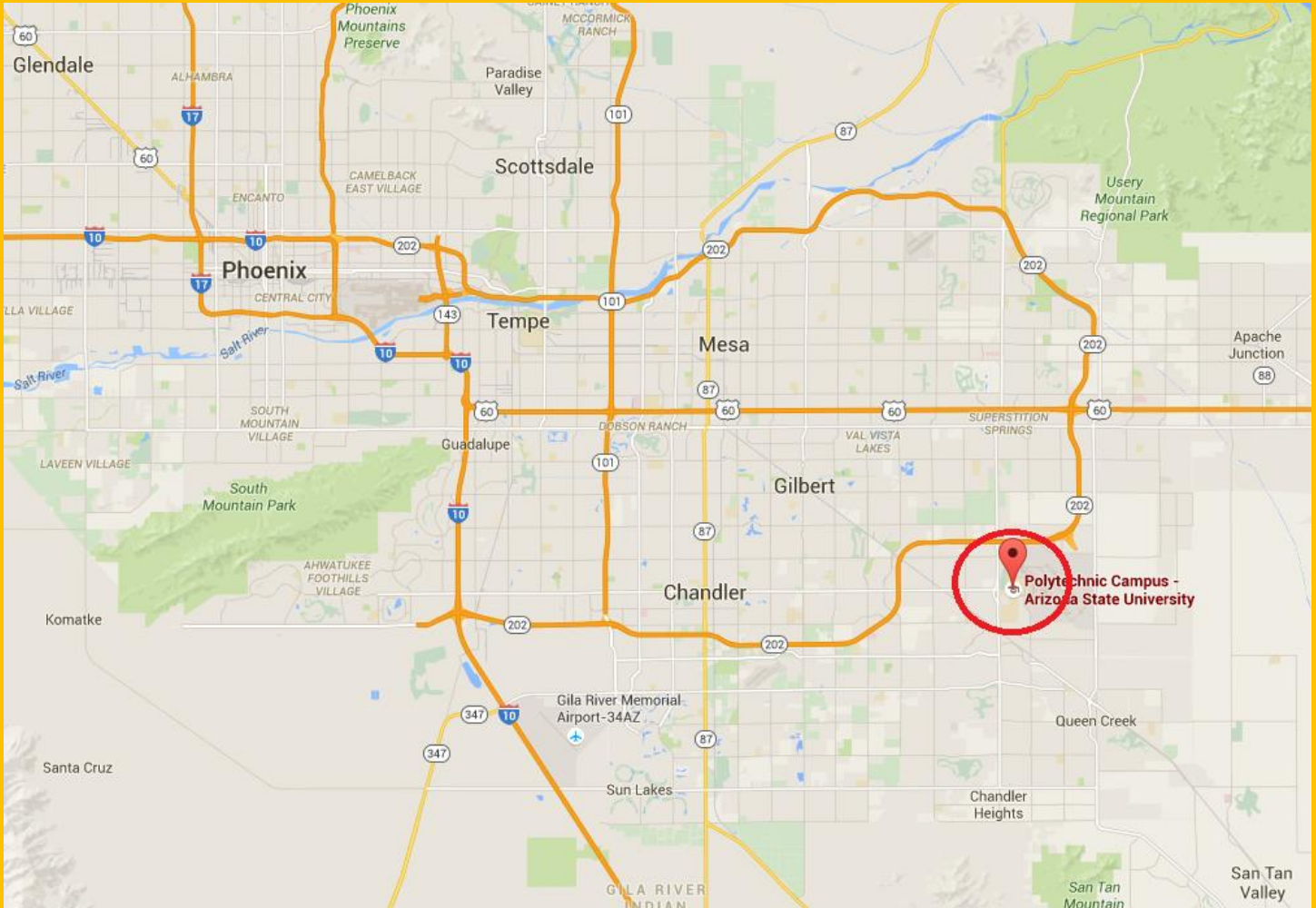
## Parking, Racer Area, and Staging

- There are two designated race parking lots with free parking on race day:
  - Lot 16A, north of the race course, accessible from Innovation Way North
  - Lot 43/46, southwest of the course, accessible from Innovation Way South.
  - **ABSOLUTELY NO PARKING ON INNOVATION WAY. YOU WILL GET TOWED.**
- **ABSOLUTELY NO PARKING ON THE INSIDE OF THE COURSE.** Cars parked on the inside of the course will get towed.
- Racer area (see map below) reserved for teams and individual riders.
- Pop-up tents **MUST** be secured with sand bags (provided by race organizers).
- Staging by the finish line at the intersection of Utah Ave and Innovation Way East

## Directions

This new race venue is on the ASU Polytechnic campus in Southeast Mesa. For most everyone, the easiest way to the race course is following the 202 loop toward southeast Mesa and exiting either on E Williams Field Road (Exit 40) or S Power Road (Exit 36). From there, go east if on E William Field Road or south if on S Power Road and follow directions to the ASU Polytechnic campus. Innovation Way circles the campus and you can take it either way to get to the race venue, which is in the southeast corner of campus, just west of the Mesa Gateway Airport.

For Google Maps or similar programs, you can search for “E Texas Ave, Mesa, AZ” and it will take you right to the race venue. Follow directions for parking from there.



## Promoter & Officials' Rules:

- The race will be held rain or shine.
- All awards, races, fields, payouts, and eligibility are subject to change at the discretion of the promoter and/or referees.
- All USA Cycling rules apply.
- Wheel pit: Wheels in – wheels out, and at your own risk; located next to the officials by start/finish.
- Juniors must pass roll-out (26'0", 7.93m) prior to staging for their race.
- Place the race number on the right side of your body.

## **Cash, Prizes, and Primes**

- You must attend the award presentation to receive your cash or product prize.
  - Primes will be handed out at the podium presentations or they can be picked up next to the registration tent.
  - We strongly suggest you wear your team kit for the award presentation and podium pictures.
